In January 2019, an organization named SIR RSA FOUNDATION was established by Sir Rahim Shah Akhunkhail to serve the people of Dir, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Pakistan. The Foundation was created with the aim of raising voices for community rights and promoting development in the areas of education, sports, health, and volunteerism, with a mission to empower and uplift the people of Dir.

The Foundation operates as an independent, non-governmental, non-political, and not-for-profit charitable organization, engaged in various community support initiatives including sustenance programs, education, healthcare, sports, and volunteer-driven efforts.

Sir Foundation is officially registered as a non-profit organization in Pakistan, under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 (KPK) with registration number #210/5/9296, in the office of the Provincial Registrar, Joint Stock Companies and Societies. The Foundation is managed entirely by volunteers, operating with virtually zero overhead costs, ensuring that resources go directly to those in need.

Title: Ramadan Relief Package Distribution – Community Support Program

Location: Akhunkhail House, Mandesh

Date of Activity: 11- March 2024

Sir Rahim Shah Akhunkhail Foundation organized a Ramadan Relief initiative where essential grocery packages were distributed to poor and deserving families across Tehsil Khall, Akgram, Hechkale, Rabat, Danwa, Rani, Keer Darrah, Sorbat, Sundrawal, and Jandol Miyar. In a meeting held at Akhunkhail House, Mandesh, Vice Chairman Mr. Daim Shah Khan Akhunkhail handed over the packages to dedicated volunteers, who ensured fair and timely delivery to those in need. These relief efforts aimed to support underprivileged households during the holy month of Ramadan, helping them observe the month with dignity. May Allah accept the sincere contributions and efforts of Sir Foundation and all involved—Ameen.



Community Champions: Volunteer-Led Relief Across Regions

As part of the ongoing Ramadan Relief campaign by Sir Rahim Shah Akhunkhail Foundation, our dedicated volunteers played a vital role in reaching deserving families across various regions. Mr. Saeed Ullah successfully distributed packages to 50 families in Tehsil Balambat, while Mr. Ayoob Shah Akhunkhail covered 80 deserving households in Tehsil Barawal. Mr. Najeeb Alam Khan extended support to 75 families, and Mr. Irfan Noor from Mayar made an incredible impact by reaching 120 families. Notably, Mr. Khurshaid Khan from Tehsil Kalkot provided relief to 100 families, many of whom were also affected by recent floods. Purpose of the Activity

The primary goal of this initiative was to support poor and needy individuals who cannot afford basic groceries during Ramadan. By empowering our volunteers to deliver these packages directly to the communities, the Foundation ensured transparency, fairness, and timely support.

Sir Foundation Zoom Meeting with Founder & Board of Directors on Eid-ul-Fitr Relief Planning – April 1, 2024

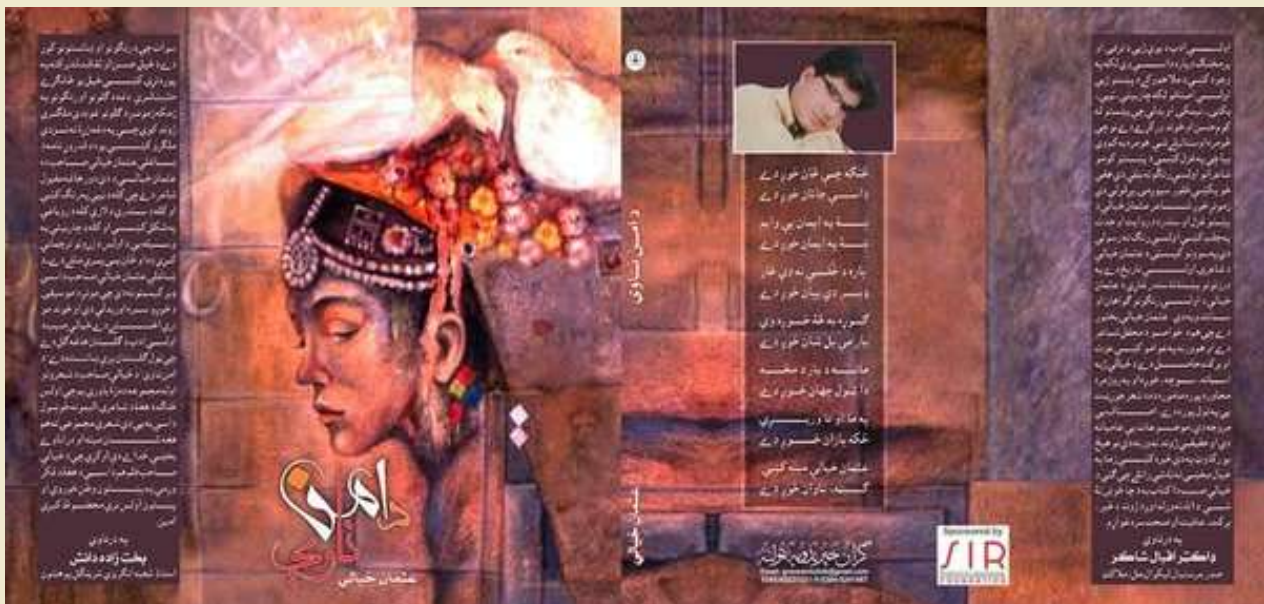

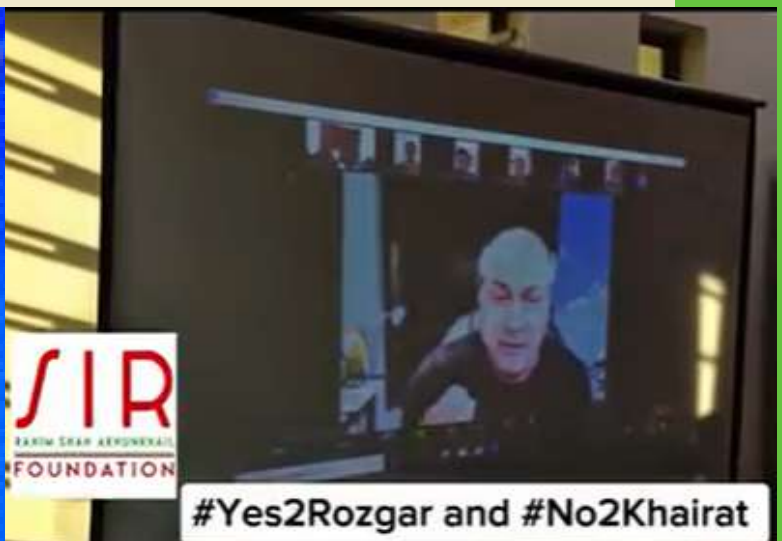


Education & Economic Empowerment – Monthly Zoom Meeting with Major Rozgar Initiative Announcement

With minimal investment and daily operational costs of just 50–75 PKR, each business is now helping individuals earn up to 2,000 PKR per day, enabling them to support their families with dignity and independence.

These micro-enterprises reflect the Foundation's mission to transform charity into sustainable income, and a major Rozgar expansion is expected to be announced after Eid, Insha'Allah.

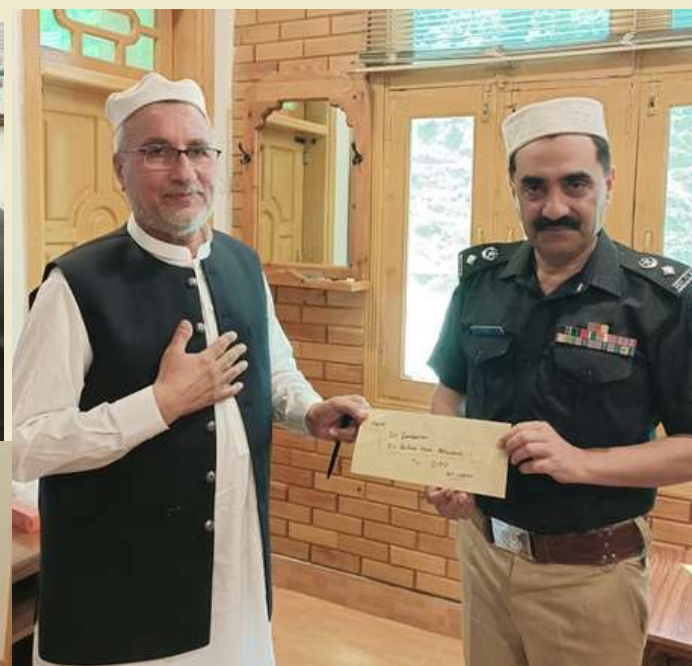


Education & Tourism Awareness – Sir Foundation Donates to Support Hospitality for Tourists in Dir
